I am an e-Learning Facilitator for Northumbria Healthcare NHS Trust, and my role is to create engaging and interactive training. The challenges are working with text heavy content and transferring a PowerPoint classroom face to face delivery learning to e-Learning.

I work with clinical and non-clinical subject matter experts and manage 350 live e-Learning and build new bite size, microlearning and full course content.

It is important not to stagnate and keep updated with market trends, so I continue to research software and design options with the goal to add to the existing bank of software tools.

I want to include AI avatars and plan to use this additional resource to help break text heavy content for e-Learning. Using avatars will change the flow of content and break up the different sections. I am quick to pick up new software and feel confident that I can evidence and demonstrate the added value AI Avatar video creation will bring. I am determined to pursue this process through the NHS procurement process to purchase the most appropriate AI video software.

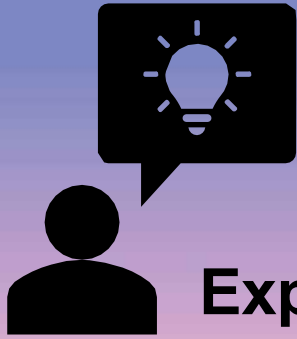

In our initial meeting, we will discuss the content and design ideas, I take this opportunity to showcase previous work. Reflective Observations and SWOT analysis

Strengths – I am an experienced and confident e-Learning content creator with over 10 years' experience of creating engaging and interactive content using Articulate and Adapt software. I am confident that I can pick up new software quickly and put it into practice and share skills then bring them to my projects at work.

Weakness – I am the only skilled e-Learning facilitator in the department, which is a business risk, time to train additional staff is time-consuming. AI video is a new software concept, there may be minimal options available on the market to meet the 3 comparative quotes required by procurement.

Opportunity – Create new partnerships with the wider Trust. Share findings and resources with colleagues across the Trust. To meet regularly in the trust technology enhanced learning meetings to demonstrate, discuss and compare AI video software.

Threats – IT infrastructure may be problematic. The procurement decision may not support my preferred AI Video software choice. Cost, new software is usually expensive. The Trust has a lengthy procurement process. Compatibility with existing software packages and Learning Management System.

Action Plan

Step 1

I will Independently research AI video software companies within 2 weeks of the project start date.

Step 2

Over the next 2 weeks, I will trial all software companies and will document pros and cons to support a business case for the procurement process. I will create content on trial accounts and document how easy, accessible, and intuitive the software packages are. I will investigate what training is available, costs, license arrangements, types of support, troubleshooting, which software outputs are available and compatibility with the Trust IT infrastructure, software and learning management system.

Step 3

In week 5, I will present my findings to the Senior management team, demonstrate the AI video software, explain strengths and weaknesses, and give reasons for the preferred provider with cost analysis.

Step 4

In week 6. I will prepare critical questions for software companies and arrange an initial meeting with myself and line manager. I will share my reported findings with appropriate colleagues and offer them an invite to meeting. This will provide the opportunity to share experiences and gather constructive feedback to support the business case. It may also provide the opportunity of shared costs if other colleagues from different business units are interested.

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Step 5

In week 7. I will check the procurement process for timescales and follow the correct procedure. I will prepare a business case with senior management for procurement and submit request.

Step 6

Within a six-month period, once software is purchased, I will increase my skills and knowledge by learning software functions and skills to present the best version of AI avatars. I will share my knowledge, hints, tips, and skills with the wider team. I will learn from the software provider by attending bespoke training, research their case studies and share AI video experiences. I will experiment the different outputs i.e.. URL, MP4, weblinks and where software can be hosted

i.e. in e-Learning software, standalone for multiple uses i.e. embedded into PowerPoint presentations, staff portal, newsletters, and emails.

Step 7

After 6 months, I will present to lead trainers and senior management on the outcome of the AI video software to promote and generate interest. I will continue to research AI video software to discover what is new and if competition has created more opportunities. If I complete regular monitoring and document findings, this will save time when I complete the purchase process for the following year and will minimise time delays to prevent any period of time being without AI software.

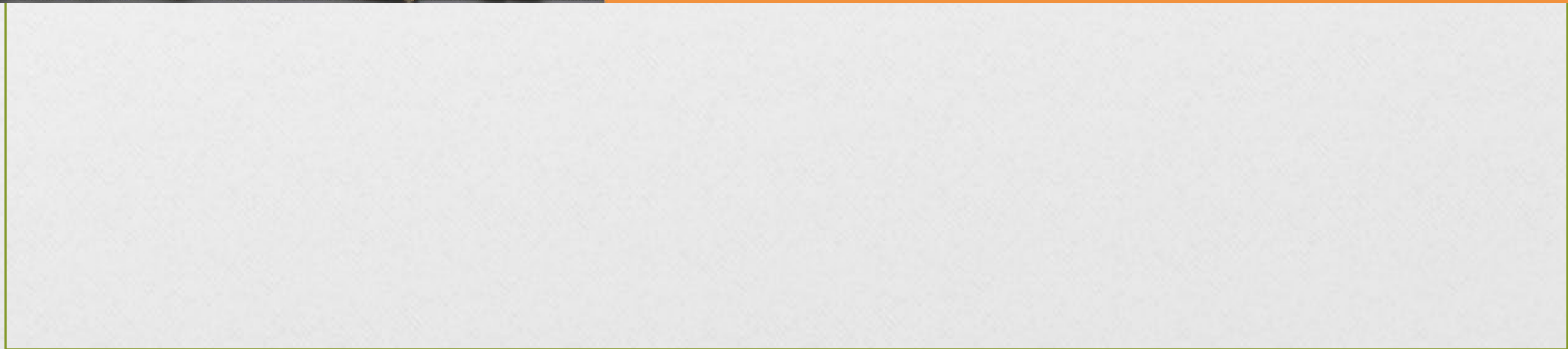
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Step 8

Within 9 months of purchasing of the AI software, I will begin the purchasing process with procurement. I will present to senior management the different projects the AI video software has been used, introduce new partnerships and development new opportunities to work collaboratively across the Trust.



Research Analysis

I started researching AI Avatar video software and discovered there is limited software available to purchase to suit my specifics.

Problems encountered were:-

- Limited video outputs to create independently without the software companies' involvement that would create additional costs
- Brand matching issues, colour corrective problems
- Speed and quality of video output
- Limited output sources i.e. only weblink or MP4 available
- Free trial limitations and quality of Video's received
- Information about their future plans to demonstrate they are ahead of competition and keeping up with trends
- Limited numbers of licenses
- Expensive software
- Ensure the software company was compatible with our IT infrastructure to ensure GDPR and Data Protection was followed according to Trust policies. This process is checked and authorised as part of our Trust procurement process.

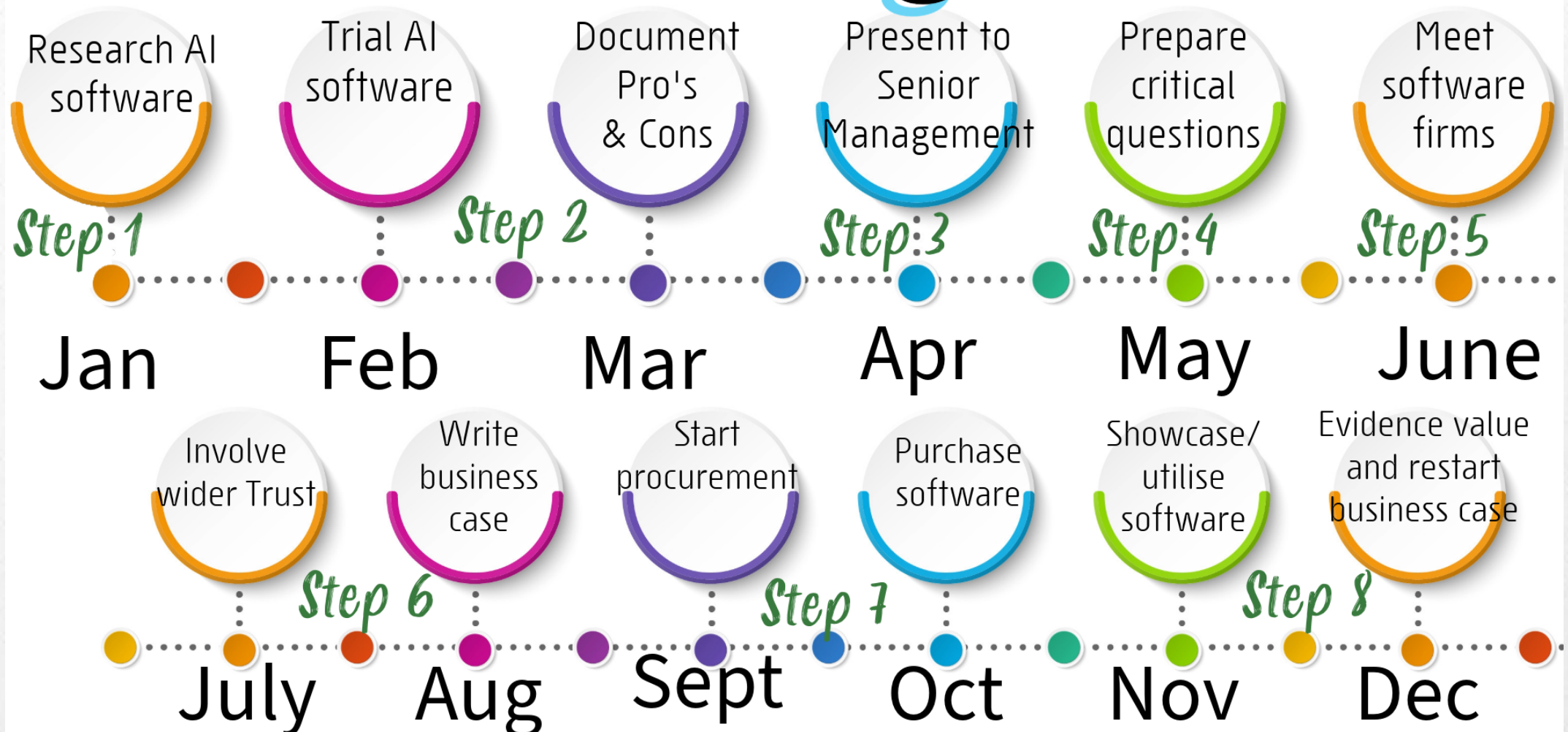

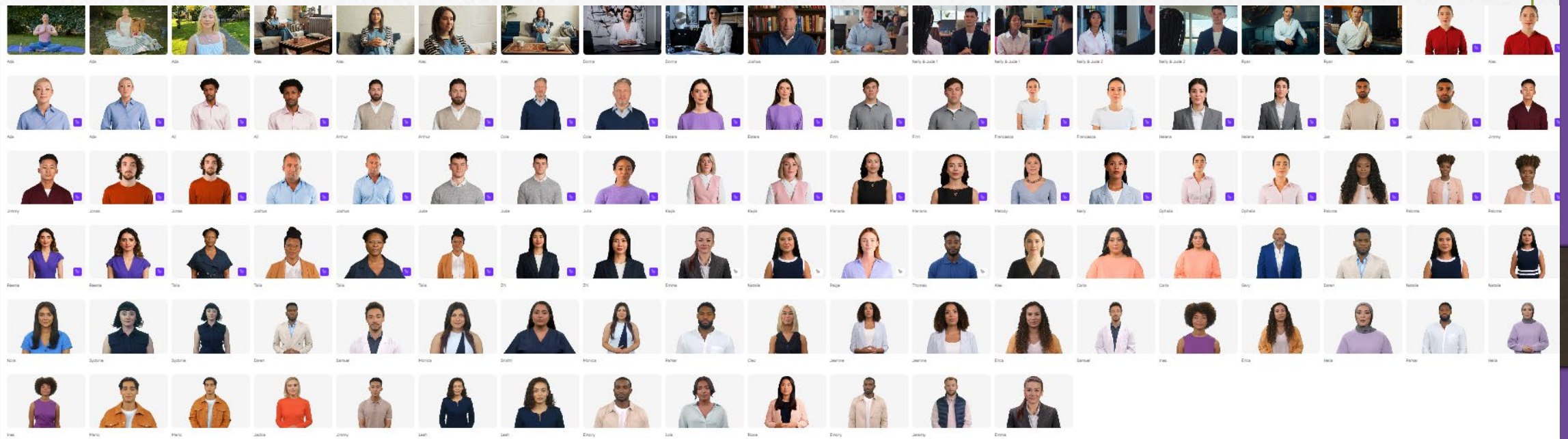

Project Challenges

Cost

3 licenses cost £25,000 per annum – so I have been showcasing the AI Avatar video software and have created over 100 AI Avatar videos that include:-

40 standalone toolbox talks

50 embedded into clinical and non-clinical e-Learning

10 emails and PowerPoint presentations

Policy breach

I was notified of a policy breach with the software company and have challenges this as I have used the media provided by the software company. It was a news bulletin for emergency preparedness where I have mocked up a train derailment and as this is false news, then they need to protect their actors. A workaround is that we can create our own Avatar and create the news bulletin, and I am working with the lead to troubleshoot.

Managing the increased in workload

Due to the increase in demand, once I created the toolbox talk template, I trained Bryan who has helped with toolbox talks and is able to support with additional requests.

Project Benefits

Time efficient

I worked on a separate project with Health & Safety to create toolbox talks which are health & safety briefs.

At the start of using the software it would take me 1 day to create an AI Avatar toolbox talk video ready for output. Once I created a template, mastered the software I could produce an output in 10 minutes.

The software is intuitive and using AI can make suggestions to edit and design which is a feature Synthesia have introduced since we purchased the software.

This means I can turnout project quickly and efficiently on the majority of times as the first output.

AI function is also a great addition to help sync the Avatar into a natural spoken word rather than text speak or when a script is provided.

Versatile software

The outputs available allow the AI Avatar video to be embedded into Articulate e-Learning software, or as a standalone video added to staff portal, learning management system, sent in an email, embed into a PowerPoint presentation.

High Demand

The project is growing and in high demand across the Trust, I'm working with critical care, emergency preparedness on new exciting project to incorporate new thinking of how to deliver key messages.

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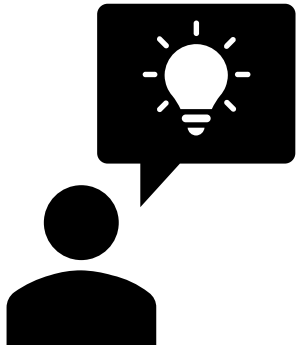
